REGULATIONS

Art. 1)

To honor the memory of Valerio Gentile, a young music lover and opera singing student who passed away tragically and prematurely, his family, in collaboration with the Conservatories of Music "Niccolò Piccinni" in Bari and "Nino Rota" in Monopoli, established in 1997 the International Opera Singing Competition – Scholarship "Valerio Gentile."

The competition is held annually on December 8 and 9 at the Teatro Sociale in Fasano.

Art. 2)

The Competition is open to young opera singers who, as of January 1, 2025, are under 32 y.o.

Art. 3)

Applications must be submitted using the admission form available online at www.valeriogentile.it and filled out in its entirety. Please carefully follow the instructions regarding file naming.

Application deadline: November 29, 2025

Applications must be accompanied by the following documents:

- A copy of a valid passport or identity document Each file must be named as follows: SUR-NAME NAME ID Doc (e.g., ROSSI MARIO ID Doc);
- One (or more) portrait photos (artistic), digital format, vertical orientation, high resolution, color. Each file must be named as follows: SURNAME NAME photo (e.g., ROSSI MARIO photo);
- Bank transfer receipt (IBAN IT65P0306967684510341258102, payable to NICOLA GENTILE President of the Cultural Association Centro Studi "Valerio Gentile") of €40.00 for applicants not requiring a pianist, or €80.00 for those requiring a pianist. Each file must be named as follows: SURNAME NAME Transfer (e.g., ROSSI MARIO Transfer). The official pianist of the Competition will be Maestro Ettore Papadia;
- Copies of the scores of the selected arias, including any personal markings for the pianist.
 Each file must be named as follows: COMPOSER Opera Character Aria (e.g., MOZART Le Nozze di Figaro Susanna Venite, inginocchiatevi).

Art. 4)

The Competition reserve the right to use audio and video recordings and photographs of the Competition rounds, and retain unlimited rights to broadcast such images via television, radio, and the internet, without compensation to participants. Participation implies tacit acceptance of these conditions.

Art. 5)

The organization reserves the right to verify the authenticity of certificates and the accuracy of submitted information.

PRIZES

Art. 6)

Prizes, awarded in the form of scholarships, are intended exclusively to support artistic projects freely chosen by the winners (e.g., tuition for academies or advanced training courses, CD/DVD productions, etc.).

- Lions Club Fasano Scholarship €500
- Scholarship offered by the Gentile–Latorre Family, in memory of Margherita Latorre, for the youngest participant in the Final Round €300
- City of Fasano Scholarship, offered by the Municipal Administration, awarded to a finalist chosen by audience vote − €500

PROGRAM AND ROUNDS

Art. 7)

The repertoire listed in the application must include four opera arias.

The chosen arias must be by different composers (with only one repetition permitted), and must include at least one aria in Italian and one in a foreign language. All arias must be performed from memory, in the original language and key, with recitative and cabaletta if applicable.

- First Round December 8 (Preliminary): performance of two arias, chosen by the Jury
- Second Round December 9 (Semifinal, morning): performance of the remaining arias not sung in the Preliminary round
- Final Round December 9, 7:30 p.m.: opera gala concert featuring the finalists, after which the winners will be announced

The order of performances will be communicated to the contestants by December 2, 2025.

Art. 8)

Contestants who have won First Prize in international opera competitions during the past two years (2024–2025) will be admitted directly to the Semifinal Round, subject to submission of the relevant documentation and Jury approval.

Art. 9)

By applying, participants fully accept these regulations as well as any subsequent modifications deemed necessary. The Jury's decisions are final and not subject to appeal.
